ACO's are not responsible for any wild animals, only domestic.

## **Dog Licenses**

The State of Maine requires that a dog is to be licensed in the municipality of the owner's residence every year.

The requirements for licensing are:

- once the puppy has reached six months of age
- if adopted, has been with the new family for 10 days
- have a valid rabies certificate

## Fees:

- \$6.00 altered and \$11.00 unaltered
- \$70.00 Nuisance Dog
- \$150.00 Dangerous Dog
- \$25.00 Impound Fee

Renewal licenses are sold starting on Oct. 15th and need to be done before January 1st. As of Feb. 1st, a \$25.00 late fee (per dog) will be applied to the license fee.
